2023 Interim Land Grant Committee session comes to a close

The Interim Land Grant Committee closed its 2023 interim session, holding its final meeting in Santa Fe on November 9th. The New Mexico Land Grant-Merced Consejo provided lunch for legislators and the audience. The Committee visited Las Vegas and toured the Lower Gallinas and Los Vigiles Land Grants, held a meeting in Peñasco and toured the Las Trampas and Santa Bárbara Land Grants, and met in Carnuel and toured the Cañón de Carnué and Manzano Land Grants. Land grants discussed how property values have made land recovery efforts difficult and their communities are continuing to be priced out of their own patrimony as their communities face gentrification and displacement. The Committee did not endorse any legislation, but Chairwoman Rep. Kristina Ortez, Sen. Linda López, Speaker Javier Martinez and other members of the committee pledged their support for legislation creating a land acquisition revolving loan fund.

Heirs and members, including past and present board members, gathered with their families to celebrate and share a meal provided by the Land Grant.

Cristóbal de la Serna Land Grant hosts matanza

La Merced de Cristobal de la Serna hosted their first matanza on November 11 at the Juan I. Gonzales Community Center in Taos. The meal was prepared by the land grant's board of trustees and other volunteers. The pork was traditionally prepared underground and served alongside potatoes, red and green chile and sopa. The Land Grant also provided entertainment with a mariachi band, a raffle, dancers and other musicians. The event was well attended by hundreds of heirs and community members from Ranchos de Taos and surrounding communities. The board of trustees from the Cristóbal de la Serna Land Grant hopes to continue this new tradition in upcoming years.





Tomé Land Grant hosts last Consejo meeting of the year

The Town of Tomé Land Grant hosted the New Mexico Land Grant Merced Consejo's December quarterly meeting on December 2 in Tomé. The Consejo planned for the 2024 annual commemoration of Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo, endorsing youth art and essay contests, selecting a commemorative pin, and distributing applications for the 2024 lifetime achievement award. Members discussed tax exemption, the Department of Transportation hardship auction, and issues with county assessors recognizing land grant patents. The Consejo endorsed legislation creating the land acquisition revolving loan fund. It also drew winners in its biannual raffle and wished to thank all of those who purchased tickets and donated prizes.
